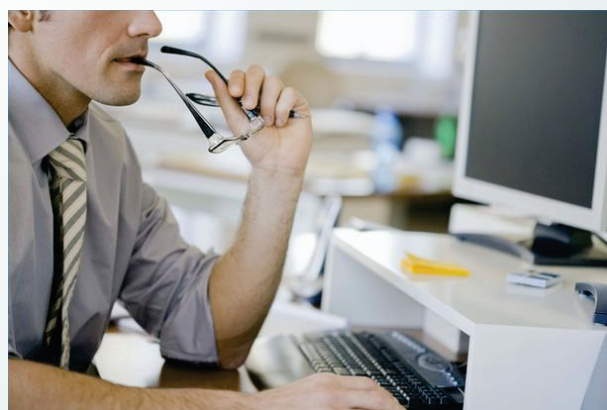
- Understand and use essential tools for handling files ,directories , command-line environments and documentation
